

Buddy's Chance Lunch and Learn for Veterinarians and Veterinary Technicians

The Buddy's Chance Lunch and Learn for Veterinarians and Technicians is designed to help you:

- Recognize when you may be in danger
- Recognize when a dog is in distress
- Modify your movements and approaches to reduce the danger to you and to reduce the stress to the dog
- Advise clients on ways to improve their dog's response to veterinary examinations and medical treatments in the future

When you sign your clinic up for a lunch and learn session with us, we provide lunch, handouts, and a presentation that includes still photos and video to teach you and your staff how to read signs of danger and stress in the dogs you work with. You'll learn safer ways to approach dogs during examination and ways to reduce the risk of injury to you and your staff and to minimize stress in your patients. You'll also learn about options for helping to prepare dogs for easier, safer examinations in the future.

Lunch and Learn sessions are taught by Cara Shannon, JD, CPDT, CAP1. Cara is highly experienced in working with aggression and handling issues. Cara works very closely with veterinarians on behavior cases and over 35 veterinarians personally refer their clients to Cara.

Cara is nationally respected in the field of dog training and behavior. She teaches other dog trainers and behavior consultants through AnimalEd, serves as a mentor for Animal Behavior college, is the Vice President of the Certification Council for Professional Dog Trainers, and author of *Bad to the Bone: Analyzing and Assessing Dog Bites*, a DVD due out this July.
